

## ADMISSIONS POLICY

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry to Salesian is normally at 11+ although subject to a place being available the College can admit pupils at other ages, including into the Sixth Form.

Pupils are admitted subject to passing the College's own Entrance Examination, held annually in January, supported by a report from their current school.

The College can only make an offer to a pupil with identified special needs where appropriate provision is made and all needs can be catered for by the College within the resources available.

We like to meet the pupils prior to the Entrance Examination. This is usually on a pre-arranged visit to the College.

The parents of prospective pupils must be in a financial position to pay fees monthly by direct debit. Bursaries are available and scholarships are awarded in the Sixth Form.

All information requested on the application for entry form must be supplied in detail as known at the time. Should circumstances regarding information requested change, the College must be informed prior to entry.

All parents who wish to make application for their children must be fully supportive of the Catholic nature, Salesian ethos and mission of the College

The offer of places will be made, subject to all satisfactory references being received, within three weeks of the Entrance Examination or as soon as possible thereafter.
